## CLANZ-BELL GULLY LAW STUDENTS' PRIZE 2004

The CLANZ-Bell Gully Prize complements the study of law by senior students and encourages them to consider legal issues specifically from the perspective of clients, whether corporate or government clients, with an NZ\$2,500 prize on offer to the winner.

Entering is easy - prepare a paper on this year's topic and submit by Monday, 30 August 2004. **This year's topic is:**

"...this new liability, created in a sidewind, is amorphous, unnecessary, a disproportionate response to rare, almost hypothetical circumstances and falls manifestly short of justifying its limitation on the right to freedom of expression affirmed by the New Zealand Bill of Rights Act."

Per Anderson J in his dissenting judgment in *Hosking v Runting* (unreported, Court of Appeal, CA 101- 03, 25 March 2004, Gault P, Keith, Blanchard, Tipping & Anderson JJ).

In light of the judgments in *Hosking v Runting*, should there be a new limit on freedom of expression which may preclude the publication of true information of a personal nature?

### RULES & REGULATIONS

The Prize is open to all senior undergraduate law students (third year or above) enrolled at any New Zealand university.

Applicants are invited to submit a paper on this topic of a maximum of **2,000 words** and of interest to practising corporate and/or government lawyers in New Zealand. Applications (on the approved application form, accompanied by a paper on the nominated topic) should be received by **Monday, 30 August 2004**. No entries received after this date will be considered by the Scholarship and Prize Committee.

All entries will be stripped of the applicant's name and contact details before being distributed to the judges. Each entry will be coded to allow for identification of applicants following judging. Applicants should ensure that there is no material in the body of their paper that may allow judges to identify them.

The winning applicant will receive a prize of **NZ\$2,500** as approved by the Scholarship & Prize Committee. Up to two runner-up prizes may also, at the sole discretion of the Scholarship & Prize Committee, be awarded, each of **NZ\$500** cash.

The Scholarship & Prize Committee shall comprise two members of the CLANZ Committee approved by the CLANZ President and one member appointed by Bell Gully. It may also include additional members appointed from time to time by agreement between CLANZ and Bell Gully.

The Prize will not necessarily be offered in any year, nor will it necessarily be awarded in any year that it is offered (for example, if the Scholarship & Prize Committee is of the view that there are insufficient entries of a suitable standard). Except for acknowledgement of receipt of entries and award notification, no correspondence will be entered into. Decisions of the Scholarship & Prize Committee regarding any aspect of the Prize (including its award) will be final and binding. All entries become the property of CLANZ. Winning and runner-up entries (whether in full or abridged) may, at CLANZ's discretion, be published on the CLANZ website and elsewhere. Application is deemed consent to these rules and such publication, and to publication of the names and photos of the Prize winner and any runners-up.
