The CLANZ-Bell Gully Scholarship supports the career development of CLANZ members, with an NZ\$5,000 scholarship package on offer to the winner.

Last year's winner, **Christine Turner of Telecom New Zealand**, used her scholarship package to attend two conferences in Canada - and meet up with the Canadian Corporate Counsel Association.

"In Canada, I met others working in the same areas of law and business and learned from leaders in these fields," said Christine. "The Globe Conference on Business and the Environment attracted speakers from around the world to discuss how businesses can benefit from improving their environmental performance.

"I also attended the Canadian Corporate Counsel Association conference, where I met some of our Canadian colleagues who share many of the same challenges as we do. Overall, I had a fantastic time, met some great people and really appreciate the ideas and experience I came away with."

Entering is easy - prepare a paper on this year's topic and submit by **Monday, 30 August 2004**.

The topic for the 2004 Scholarship is **"The role of in-house counsel as 'ethics guardian' in their organisation: security guard or champion?"**

RULES & REGULATIONS

The Scholarship is open to all CLANZ members (New Zealand lawyers employed by corporate, government and other organisations - other than in private practice) who hold a current practising certificate - except members of the Scholarship & Prize Committee and CLANZ Executive Committee members.

Applicants are invited to submit a paper on this topic of a maximum of **2,000 words** and of relevance to practising corporate and/or government lawyers in New Zealand. Applications (on the approved application form, accompanied by a paper on the nominated topic) should be received by **Monday, 30 August 2004**. No entries received after this date will be considered by the Scholarship and Prize Committee.

All entries will be stripped of the applicant's name and contact details before being distributed to the judges. Each entry will be coded to allow for identification of applicants following judging. Applicants should ensure that there is no material in the body of their paper that may allow judges to identify them.

The winning applicant may select a scholarship package to the value of **NZ\$5,000** as approved by the Scholarship & Prize Committee. The package should be designed to assist the winner advance his or her professional career as a corporate or government lawyer. Examples of suitable prize packages include airfare, accommodation and fees to attend an appropriate overseas conference (eg American Corporate Counsel Association, Australian Corporate Lawyers Association, etc), or to attend a management or legal skills course in New Zealand, Australia or elsewhere. If the selected approved package is less than the maximum value of NZ\$5,000, the balance, up to a maximum of NZ\$1,000, may be awarded in cash. The winner will also receive complimentary registration to the 2005 CLANZ Conference. Any expenses over and above the Scholarship value will be the winner's sole responsibility. Up to two runner-up prizes may also, at the sole discretion of the Scholarship & Prize Committee, be awarded, each of **NZ\$500** cash. The Scholarship package must be used by September 2005.

The Scholarship & Prize Committee shall comprise two members of the CLANZ Committee approved by the CLANZ President and one member appointed by Bell Gully. It may also include additional members appointed from time to time by agreement between CLANZ and Bell Gully.

The Scholarship will be awarded at the discretion of the Scholarship & Prize Committee. Except for acknowledgement of receipt of entries and award notification, no correspondence will be entered into. Decisions of the Scholarship & Prize Committee regarding any aspect of the Scholarship (including its award) will be final and binding. All entries become the property of CLANZ. Winning and runner-up entries (whether in full or abridged) may, at CLANZ's discretion, be published on the CLANZ website and elsewhere. Application is deemed consent to these rules and such publication, and to publication of the names and photos of the Scholarship winner and any runners-up.
